mapear is a non-profit organization dedicated to ensuring that children and adolescents in situations of social vulnerability have access to fundamental and universal rights, as established by the statute of the child and adolescent. the project offers regular workshops in percussion, dance, graphic arts, sports, capoeira, environmental education, breaking, circus, and pedagogical support for young people aged 6 to 15.




# transformed lives: luis otavio

### transformed lives aline

recalling significant childhood experiences can be emotional. in this testimony, **aline** shares how the mobile cinema project brought back precious memories and impacted her community.

"i confess that i got emotional when the first film started. when i was about 8 years old, i had a similar cinema experience here in the neighborhood, and that memory marked me deeply. after that, there was nothing like it. when they talked about the possibility of the project happening here again, i thought about how many children could have the same experience. i am very happy and proud to see the children in the community having this opportunity. i am sure they will remember it for the rest of their lives."
