the social idol project offers free basketball classes for children and adolescents aged 7 to 14. with an exclusive methodology, the project goes beyond the technical fundamentals of the sport, integrating crosscutting themes and essential reflections for life in society. the classes are held during after-school hours, providing a complete and enriching development.

erika, the mother of a student benefiting from the project, highlights the importance of sports for the physical and social development of children. she celebrates the opportunity for her daughter to participate in a basketball project, something she herself valued in her youth.

"my name is erika, i am 44 years old. my daughter is called isabela, she is 11 years old and is now participating in the social project to train basketball. it is something i had been looking for but couldn't find here in the city of ribeirão, because it was quite outdated. while growing up, i played volleyball, played basketball, participated in projects, which was very good for my development. i was looking for projects for isabela to participate in because i believe that sports are good. even if she doesn't become a professional, it is good for the child's development. today, we are in a digital age, where children only stay on digital devices, only on cell phones, only on tablets. sports are good to get these children off digital devices, socializing, and developing physically. so, for me, it has been great."

the **griots association** is a osc composed of over 150 volunteers who use storytelling as a powerful tool to work on the feelings and creativity of patients in hospitals. by immersing themselves in captivating narratives, patients find a form of emotional expression and a temporary escape from the hospital environment. this practice not only humanizes the environment, making it more welcoming and less intimidating, but also has a positive impact on patient recovery, accelerating medical treatments by promoting well-being and stress relief.
